The Federation of European Film Directors (FERA), founded in 1980, is the only organisation representing film and TV directors at EU level. With 44 directors' associations as members from 34 countries, we speak for more than 20,000 European screen directors, representing their cultural, creative and economic interests at national and European level.

FERA works to promote the directors' cultural, creative and economic interests at national and European level through workshops, training sessions and policies that maximize the creative and commercial potential of the European audiovisual industry.

Missions
